

Directions to Motorola Center


From downtown Chicago, take the Kennedy Expressway west toward O'Hare Airport and Rockford. Follow the Rockford signs to the Northwest Tollway (I-90). Exit the Tollway at Illinois Rt. 53 north (Rolling Meadows) and remain in the right lane. Immediately exit Rt. 53 to Rt. 62 (Algonquin Road). Follow the exit ramp around to the stoplight and turn right onto Algonquin Road. Proceed west past several stoplights to the intersection of Algonquin and Meacham Roads at which Motorola Center is located. The Center can be entered via the Visitor Center which is located at the West Drive off of Algonquin Road.

An alternate route from Chicago is by way of the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) west and north, exiting onto Rt. 53 as described above.

The distance from the Chicago Loop to the Motorola Center is about 30 miles and driving time is approximately 45 minutes to an hour.

If driving north or south on the Tri-State Tollway (I-294), exit west to either the Northwest Tollway (I-90) or to the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) and proceed as noted above.

From the O'Hare Airport, follow the "Exit to City" signs for 1-1/2 miles. Then follow the Rockford signs to the Northwest Tollway (I-90) and proceed as noted above.




Access and Parking

The 325-acre Motorola Center in Schaumburg, Illinois, is the world headquarters for the Corporate Offices and home to the Corporate Information Office, the Galvin Center for Continuing Education (Motorola University), the Motorola Museum of Electronics, and the Land Mobile Products Sector, which includes the Worldwide Parts Division.


The Visitor Center, located at the West Drive off of Algonquin Road, is a 24-hour reception area. All visitors are directed to use this entry point (A) to access Motorola Center. There is no entry to the center from the Northwest Tollway.


