

FLU SHOTS FOR HIGH RISK EMPLOYEES

October 1, 2009 - Thursday - 9:00 A.M. - 1:30 P.M

LOCATION: Wilson Hall - ES&H training room (East entrance)



1. You are eligible to receive a flu vaccination FREE if you are: Active, Full-Time regular employees – or – Term and Temporary employees and are in one of these: **HIGH RISK CATEGORIES:**
**Persons aged 65 years and older *Persons with chronic medical conditions*
This includes heart disease, asthma, and other chronic disorders of the pulmonary or cardiovascular systems; diabetes, kidney diseases, blood disorders, or weakened immune system. The immune system can be affected by various diseases including HIV/AIDS, long-term steroid treatment, or cancer treatment with radiation or drugs.

Persons who can transmit flu to those at high risk. This includes health-care workers involved in direct patient care and employees who provide home care to persons at high risk.
2. The following groups are **NOT** eligible to receive the flu vaccination:
Contractors – Family members of employees – Visitors – Experimenters – Seasonal employees – Dayworkers/On call – or Retirees.
3. *Women who are/may be pregnant must bring a doctor's note in order to get a flu shot.*

NO CONSENT FORM AND NO FERMILAB ID CARD MEANS NO VACCINATION.

Bring proof of eligibility: Fermi ID card
